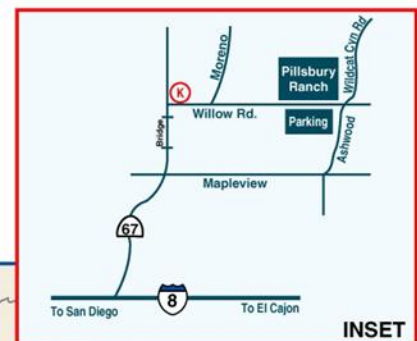


San Diego Tracking Team
