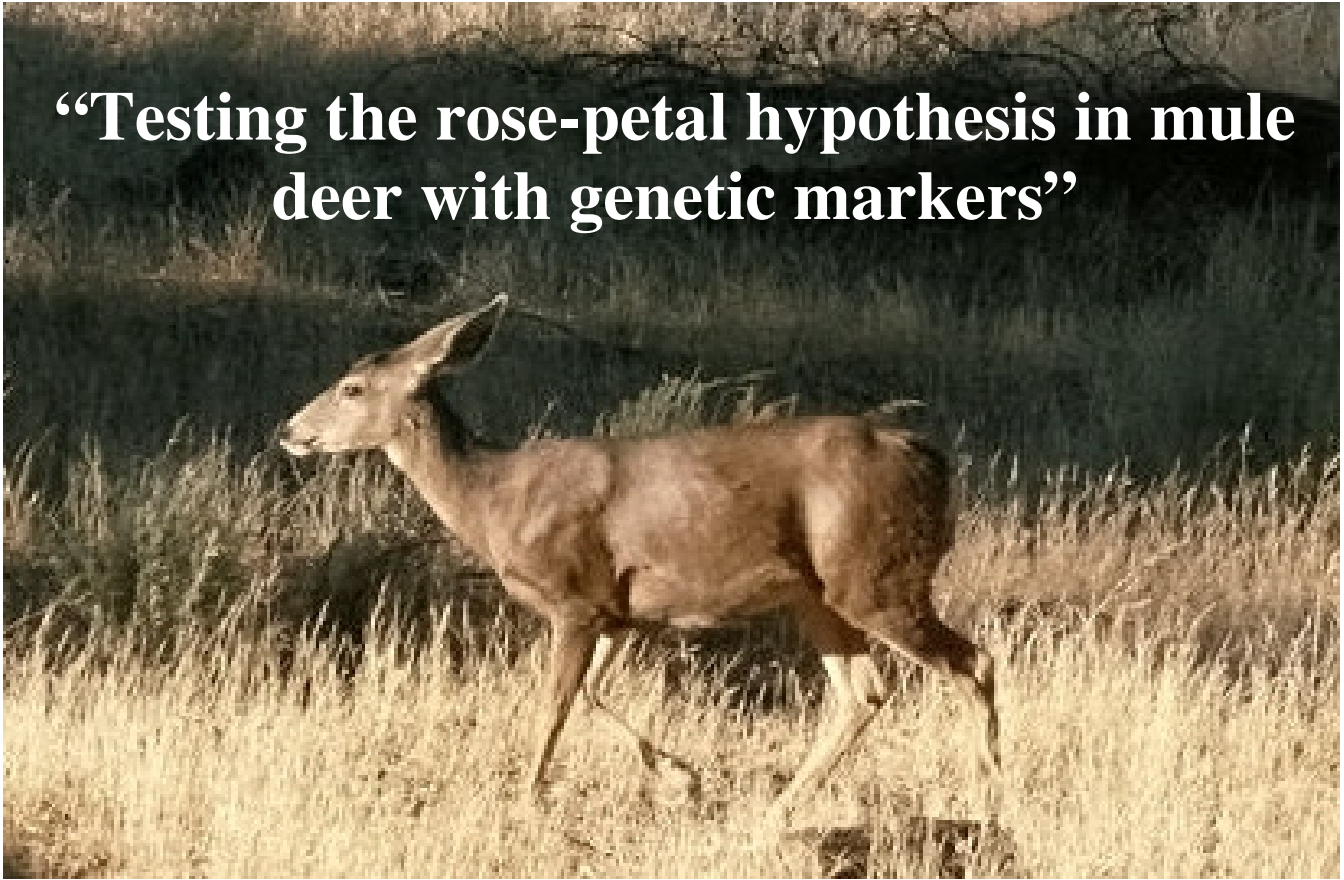

## **How Effective Are San Diego’s Wildlife Corridors?**

**Join us at Mission Trails Regional Park for a presentation by Anna Mitelberg on research performed by the Bohonak Laboratory at San Diego State University with the help of the San Diego Tracking Team on genetic monitoring of the southern mule deer across the urban canyons and parks of San Diego County. Over 500 scat samples were collected from 15 sites, and 263 genotypes representing 153 unique individuals were recovered. Learn first-hand from Anna about the effectiveness of linkage corridors for southern mule deer in San Diego County.**
